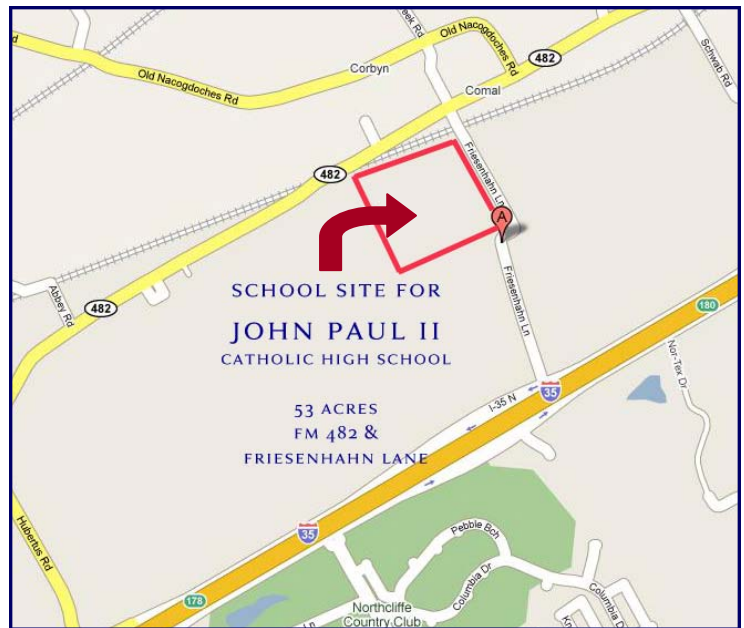
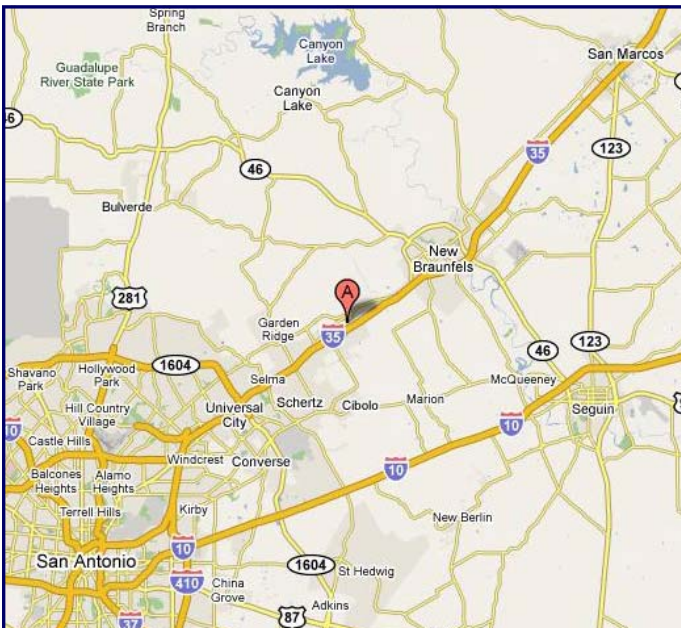

WE HAVE OUR LAND!

The Archdiocese and John Paul II Catholic School have purchased 53 acres at the corner of Friesenhahn Lane and FM 482, a quarter mile off IH-35. As planned, the school site is less than twenty minutes from Seguin, and less than ten minutes from Selma, Schertz, and New Braunfels. The eventual full-service high school campus envisioned in our master plan, which includes a chapel, athletic fields, and fine arts space, fits well within the fifty-three acres. “We couldn’t be more pleased to have found this parcel of land, with its location, its proximity to IH-35. It’s all what we were hoping for,” said Craig Zgabay, School Council President. “More than that, this is the next step to opening our school in August 2009,” he added. The school is now forging ahead with the architect, ERO, to develop the master plan and phase one in particular, which includes site work and the necessary square footage for year one.



OUR NEIGHBORS

The land, just down Friesenhahn Lane, is one quarter mile from IH-35. The next exit north is Schwab Road. In the neighborhood are (a) the new Lacks Furniture Distribution Center; (b) St. Joseph’s Chapel (maintained by Sts. Peter and Paul Parish, New Braunfels); and (c) Comal Elementary (a Comal ISD School).
