



School supplies for students for 2009-2010

This is the general school supplies list for students. In many cases, students have these resources from previous years and can just reuse them going forward.

	• Pens (blue, black, and red)
	• Highlighters (more than one color)
	• Mechanical pencils (more than one) and erasers
	• <i>The tools for using an organizational system:</i> binders and dividers OR pocket folders for each subject OR an accordion ‘pocket’ file would be examples of such a system. Ideally, it is a tested system that has worked in the past for the student.
	• Four (4) narrow/college ruled composition books (the smaller, bound notebooks)
	• A source of paper for notes and work (whether a package of loose leaf or in a notebook depends on organizational method). Paper has to be removable for assignments turned in.
	• A USB flash drive (2 MB or larger)
	• A Bible (We are not specifying the version, but it has to be one that a student can bring to school and use daily in theology class, meaning it should not be a family heirloom.)
	• Copies of the summer reading books
	• A package of lined index cards
	• Backpack or satchel (Note: A normal-sized school backpack is recommended; wheeled backpacks are acceptable. The only ones not allowed are large, backpacking/hiking packs or luggage-type bags.)
	• Scotch tape
	• Colored pencils or fine tip markers (please, no permanent markers or Sharpies®)
	• Lunch container of some kind. Our plans now include having food brought in three times per week. This means that twice per week, all students will need to bring their lunches. We will have small microwaves to warm up meals, but not to prepare a meal or thaw a frozen entrée. The lunches can be stored in the school office refrigerator.
FOR BIOLOGY	
	• Simple three ring binder (1½” size)
	• Binder dividers
	• Graph paper
	• Scientific calculator. This is not a graphing calculator, but it is not a simple four function calculator either. A scientific calculator has sin, cos, tan, square root, squares or x^2 , cubes or x^3 , and parentheses. They usually cost \$10-15.
NOTE: The school will provide all students with a daily planner.	
NOTE: The school will provide all students will a photo ID and lanyard.	
NOTE: The school will be purchasing a set of graphing calculators for this school year, in order to determine the level of use in class. In future years, students may be asked to purchase one for specific classes, but not this year.	
NOTE: Book covers will be provided where needed.
