



School supplies for students for 2018-2019

This is the general school supplies list for students. In many cases, students have these resources from previous years and can just reuse them going forward.

	• Pens (blue , black, and red)
	• Highlighters (more than one color)
	• Mechanical pencils (more than one) and erasers
	• <i>The tools for using an organizational system:</i> binders and dividers OR pocket folders for each subject OR an accordion ‘pocket’ file would be examples of such a system. Ideally, it is a tested system that has worked in the past for the student.
	• Six (6) narrow/college ruled composition books (the smaller, bound notebooks)
	• A source of paper for notes and work (whether a package of loose leaf or in a notebook depends on organizational method). Paper has to be removable for assignments turned in.
	• A USB flash drive (2 MB or larger) – required for all classes
	• A Bible (We are not specifying the version, but it has to be one that a student can bring to school and use daily in theology class, meaning it should not be a family heirloom.)
	• Copies of the summer reading books
	• A package of lined index cards (and more at home!)
	• Backpack or satchel (Note: A normal-sized school backpack is recommended. The only ones not allowed are large, backpacking/hiking packs or luggage-type bags.)
	• Colored pencils or fine tip markers (please, no permanent markers or Sharpies®)
	• Two extra binders
	• Two extra folders
FOR SCIENCE COURSES	
	• Simple three-ring binder
	• Binder dividers
	• Graph paper
FOR ALL MATH CLASSES	
	• Graphing calculator: We require all students to have a graphing calculator. For those who have to buy one, please purchase the TI-84 Plus Graphing Calculator. These can run between \$85-120. NOTE: Some of these calculators have rechargeable batteries, so make sure to keep your charging cord in your backpack.
FOR GEOMETRY STUDENTS - protractor and compass

	• ONE (1) package of dry erase markers
	• ONE (1) roll of paper towels
